

GRIMKIN, THE INQUISITIVE

A pure black sphinx cat with prominent fangs and claws. Grimkin is a feytouched cat; at birth, they were possessed by a fey spirit and became sapient. They have spent the majority of their young life hunting rats in the city, exploring structures, and stealing whatever they like from whoever they want. Pretending to be an ordinary cat has its perks.

Features

Cat. Bite, No Hands, +2 to Dex. **Urchin.** City Secrets.

Rogue. Expertise (Acrobatics, Thieves' Tools), Sneak Attack, Cunning Action.

Inquisitive. Ear for Deceit, Eye for Detail, Insightful Fighting

Proficiencies

Skills. Acrobatics, Insight, Investigation, Perception, Sleight of Hand, Stealth

Saves. Dex, Int

Armor & Weapons. Light armor. Due to No Hands, the usual weapon proficiencies for a cat are limited to magic items, knives, shortswords, and daggers. They can, however, shoot a crossbow that is held stationary, or attack with a piercing weapon strapped to their back.

Tools. Thieves' tools, disguise kit.

Inventory

A small knife, a map of Waymouth, a catnip mouse, their mother's neck charm, a leather armor shoulder harness with pockets, thieves' tools, a belt pouch containing 10 gp, a burglar's pack, two shortswords, and two daggers.

"Other cats taught me to survive. People never helped me much."
